

As per 'The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012' training must be refreshed annually or more frequently if there are changes to, work methods and types of work, equipment used or when gaps in competency are identified. Refresher Training should be based on a Training Needs Analysis (TNA) to ensure the skills and knowledge are maintained and developed on an ongoing basis.

- Certificate of Handover (EM10).
- Risk Assessment and Plans of Work.
- Emergency Procedures.
