CITB Demolition Plant Operation Apprenticeship Level 2

What is a Demolition Plant Operator?

This Apprenticeship has been designed in close consultation with the Demolition Industry and sets out to offer Demolition Plant Operatives an appreciation of all aspects of demolition.

Demolition Plant Operatives are trained to demolish or dismantle buildings and other structures. Once the demolition is complete, the site must be cleared and the debris moved, often for recycling.

Apprenticeship Summary	
Duration	 Year 1 - 12-weeks training plus testing at the National Construction College (NCC) Year 2 - Employer-based work experience with assessment for the Level 2 NVQ in Plant Operation carried out by the NCC.
Entry requirements	There are no specific requirements, although some candidates may need to attend the college for further tests to attain Level 1 Functional Skills.
Assessment and Training	This is a combination of classroom-based theory and practical training with site assessments.
Qualifications / Certification	 Level 2 NVQ in Plant Operations (Construction) Level 2 Diploma in Plant Operations CPCS Red Trained Operator Card Level 1 Functional Skills.
